The Basic size of a vendor booth is 10 feet (frontage).

The Pow-Wow committee reserves the right to instruct the vendor to remove all unauthorized merchandise and materials deemed inappropriate from display and for sale, and to remove the vendor from the Pow-Wow grounds if necessary.





VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Payment is required to guarantee your space. Vendors will not be allowed to set up until payment
 is made in full.
- Vendors are required to provide one garbage can outside your booth and be responsible for all clean up in and around your booth.
- Booth set-up is required to be completed by 11am on Saturday. Raffle item will be picked up at your booth on Friday after 3 PM by a Pow-Wow committee representative.
- 4. One vehicle may be maintained behind your booth or in the parking lot off of the Road (directions to this will be available). Vendors are asked to reduce in and out driving activities due to traffic congestion.
- 5. The Pow-Wow committee works in a diligent manner to maintain a high quality of vendors at the Benoit First Nation Mawoi'mi. Novelty items and toys, i.e. Frisbees, squirt guns, toy flutes, whistles etc. are not allowed to be sold. All items are subject to review and if seen as inappropriate, offensive or questionable, a Pow-Wow representative will ask that the items be removed.
- All pets are restricted from being on or around the Pow-Wow grounds. If you have pets at your booth you will be required to be on a leash at all times and you are required to clean up after them.
- 7. ZERO TOLERENCE FOR ALCOHOL, DRUGS, DRUG PARAPHERNALIA OR WEAPONS.

Liability Waiver Agreement

The undersigned hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Benoit First Nation, sponsors and affiliates from all liability that may be caused, either directly or indirectly, by the actions of the undersigned, during the this event.
